- Sani Pass,
- Ramatseliso's Gate, le
- Peka Bridge.

Tefo ea Lekhetho malibohong a boletsoeng ka holimo bakeng sa thepa e kenang kahara naha ea Lesotho e tla etsoa ka chelete e seng ka setlankana sa Lekhetho (tax invoice). Litlankana tse joalo (tax invoices) li tla amoheloa ele mokhoa ho lefa Lekhetho feela boemong boo ho nang le tumello (concession) e koptjoang ho setsi sa litsebeletso tsa lekhetho Afrika Boroa (SARS).

Public notice

The public is hereby notified that RSA tax invoices are no longer accepted as means of payment of import VAT for goods imported into Lesotho at the following ports of entries:

- Tele Bridge,
- Makhaleng Bridge
- Ramatseliso's Gate,
- Sani Pass, and
- Peka Bridge.

Payment of import VAT for the goods imported into Lesotho through the above – mentioned Ports of Entry will strictly be payable by cash/card only. This change will affect both traders and private shoppers. The public is further notified that only Clients with concession obtainable from South African Revenue Services (SARS) will be allowed to use the tax invoice as a form of payment on the ports of entries listed above.
