The Revenue Services Lesotho has launched, and it is currently executing the Lesokoana Strategy 2024-27. Among other important objectives of the strategy is "to create an exciting, positive and productive work environment for all staff". One of the milestones intended to achieve this, is through establishing Employees' Social Club. The intention is to deliver this exciting initiative, though giving an opportunity/ exposure to emerging young talents of architects given the size of the project, and as a way of giving back to the community under its Corporate Social Investment Programme. RSL wishes to invite students in the Architectural Programme and recent graduates in the Architectural Studies field to express interest in this project.

- a) **Provide technical advice**: meet with the project team and advise the Revenue Services Lesotho (RSL) on the most appropriate solution in line with the entire concept;
- b) **Design Development:** Create the initial design concepts, incorporating the client's vision, functional requirements, and aesthetic considerations;
- c) Planning and Documentation: Prepare detailed drawings and specifications that serve as a blueprint for the construction process. This includes floor plans, elevations, and construction details and any other details;
- d) **Regulatory Compliance:** Ensure that designs comply with local building codes, zoning laws, and other regulatory requirements;
- e) **Coordination:** Collaborate with engineers, contractors, and other professionals to ensure that all aspects of the project align and function well together;
- f) **Sustainability Considerations**: Incorporate sustainable practices into their designs, considering energy efficiency, material selection, and environmental impact; and
- g) **Problem-Solving:** the person awarded the work will work along RSL Project manage to address challenges that may arise during the construction process, whether related to design, site conditions, or client requests.
